

MEDICAL EXAMINATION FOR IMMIGRATION TO CANADA.

Designated Panel Physician Dr. **Livija Caune-Kazocina** is approved by Canadian Government to do the medical examination for immigrants.

To undergo the medical examination you need:

1. Medical report IMM1017 E, with IME number, if the client's file exists in CIC.
Upfront medical examinations are performed when clients report to a panel physician for their IME before a visa application has been submitted to CIC.
2. Passport,
3. Medical reports, if you have had serious medical history (operation, hospital treatment, medications use). Females-gynaecologist's report (valid 1 year.)
4. Glasses (if necessary).

Payment:

1. Adults (15 years and older) – Euro 150.0 (which includes laboratory tests, physical examination and documentation, translation).

+ Euro 42.00 for chest X-ray (from age 11, place - ARS Clinic, Skolas street 5),

children under 15 years – Euro 128.0

Payment will be via internet bank, after appointment.
